Mormon Doctrine	Versus	The Bible
Sin happened so that children could be born (2 Nephi 2:22-23)	VS.	Children were ordained to be born before sin entered the world (Genesis 1:28)
Jesus was born in Jerusalem (Alma 7:10)	VS.	Jesus was born in Bethlehem (Matthew 2:5)
Christ's church existed before Christ's birth (Mosiah 18:17)	VS.	The church was brought into existence after the death of Christ (Matthew 16:18; Acts 1:6; Acts 2; Colossians 1:13)
Darkness accompanied the death of Christ for a span of three days (Helaman 14:17, 20-27)	VS.	The time span of darkness was three hours (Luke 23:44)
There were Christians before Christ's birth (Alma 46:13-16)	VS.	The name Christian began to be used first in Antioch - after the death of Christ (Acts 11:26)
Baptism, in order to be added to the church, was done prior to the church being established (Mosiah 25:18)	VS.	Baptism in order to be added to the church began on the day the church was found (Acts 2:41-47)
Those who have never heard the gospel are saved, and the blood of Christ atones for their sins (Mosiah 3:11)	VS.	Ignorance will not save you; obedience to the gospel is essential for salvation (2 Thessalonians 1:6-9)
Before the death of Christ the grace of God is extend in the waters of baptism (Mosiah 18:16)	VS.	Grace is extended in the waters of baptism after the death of Christ (Eph. 1:6; 2:4-10; Titus 3:1-5)
The Bible is not a sufficient guide alone (2 Nephi 29:1-4)	VS.	The Bible is enough (2 Peter 1:3, et al)
Give a tenth of your income to the church (D&C 64:23; 119:1-5)	VS.	Under the New Testament we are to give as we purpose in our hearts (2 Corinthians 9:7)
Enoch was 430 years old when he was translated (D&C 107:49)	VS.	Enoch was 365 when God took him (Genesis 5:23)
